TERMS AND CONDITIONS

TEAM TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Registration

- * A one off \$40 registration fee must be made with the submission of the team registration form.
- * There is a \$40 weekly match fee for all teams. This must be paid PRIOR to your match each week. A receipt will be given which the umpire will collect before your match. NO RECEIPT NO GAME. The umpire will not collect payments.
- * Alternatively a \$300 up front payment can be made (a saving of over \$100 for most teams). This includes REGISTRATION and ALL MATCH FEES for the semester (including finals). If your team takes up this option you will not be required to produce a receipt each match.
- * There will be a total of nine rounds and two finals weeks, with no games being held during the Easter and Semester Break.
- * Grand Final costs are covered by Unigym, however teams must pay the match fee for Semi-Finals.
- * If your team cannot be placed in a roster due to a large number of teams, you will be given a full refund on your Registration Fee & First Game Fee.
- * Basketball, Futsal and Touch teams must nominate a team colour when registering. Teams are required to wear their nominated colour each week or they will be penalised match points.
- * Games must start at the allotted time to ensure the roster runs on time.
- * Rough behaviour will not be tolerated. Unigym has the right to remove a team demon starting rough behaviour from the roster at any time.
- * To be eligible for finals, players must have played in a minimum of 3 matches for the team they are registered with. Player names can be added to registration forms until the completion of round 5.
- * ALL players participate at their own risk and are wholly responsible for their own actions.

Complaints

- * Any complaints should be made in writing and directed to the Unigym Team Leader.

Forfeits

- * Teams forfeiting are expected to give Unigym at least three (3) days notice. Any team who does not will incur a \$25 fee.

Prize Winners

- * Winners and Runners-Up of each Grand Final will receive medals and prizes as nominated by sponsors.
 - * Prize winners must be present at presentation night to receive their prizes. Prizes cannot be collected at a later date without prior notification.

Roster

- * All sports will be run over 12 weeks; 9 rounds, Semi-Finals, and Grand Finals. The Easter and Semester Break will have no rostered games.
- * Games that occur on Public Holidays will be postponed to another available day.

Scoring

- * Scoring is kept by the referee or umpire.
- * Win = 4 points, Loss = 2 points, Draw = 3 points, Forfeit = 0 points.
- * Failure to pay the full match fee on the night will result in forfeited points (0).
- * If a team is late, match points will be deducted according to the time the match is held from commencing.

- * All referees and umpires officiate games based on the same generic version of the rules.
